

ITI ADMISSION PROCESS

DVET Maharashtra ITI Admission 2020 application and official notification will be released in the first week of June 2020. All the application forms will be made available on the official web portal of the conducting body.

Department of Vocational Education & Training (DVET), Maharashtra is the department under the State Government of Maharashtra that conducts an online process every year for the admission of candidates into various governments or private Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) of the state.

Interested candidates will get all the necessary details regarding DVET Maharashtra ITI admissions 2020 in the given article. It includes information about the admission application such as application form, schedule, fee, eligibility criteria, trades, result, counseling etc.

DVET Maharashtra ITI Admission Application Procedure

The admission procedure is completely online and is done through a centralized online admission system. The admission process includes basically five steps. Below we have shared a brief detail about all the steps involved in the application process-

- **Step 1- Candidates registration**

In this step, fresh candidates have to register themselves by providing the necessary information such as the mobile number and email address. Those who have already registered can skip this step.

- **Step 2- Application submission**

In this step, applicants have to submit the online application form by filling all the required information.

- **Step 3- Confirmation of Application**

In this stage, the application of the applicant will be confirmed by the conducting authority on the basis of the selection criteria.

- **Step 4- Seat Allotment**

DVET, Maharashtra will finally allot seats to the candidates on the basis of the data of the applicants.

- **Step 5- Admission to Institute**

The last and the final step is the admission of the candidate to the allotted Institute. Applicants have to carry all the required documents to the allotted institute for verification.

ITI DVET Maharashtra Application Fee 2020

Applicants have to pay a certain amount of the application fee depending on their category.

Here we have shared the category-wise application fee applicable for each category of the candidate in the admission process-

- **Unreserved category (UR)**- Rs.150/-
- **Reserved category** – Rs.100/-
- **Candidates from outside Maharashtra state**- Rs.300/-
- **Non-Residential Indians (NRIs)**- Rs.500/-

Category-wise reservation in DVET ITI admissions is as follows-

OBC	19%
VimuktJati/ Denotified Tribes (VJ/DT)	3%
Nomadic tribes (NT)-B	2.5%
Nomadic Tribes (NT)-C	3.5%
Nomadic Tribes (NT)-D	2%

General category	50%
Total reservation	100%

Note: Reservation percentage for all the categories changed as per the rules and policy of the State Government.

ITI ADMISSION PROCESS

DVET Maharashtra ITI 2020 Seat Allotment

Once the application is confirmed, seats will be allotted to the candidates on the basis of application, preferences filled and other factors. After the allocation of seats, candidates have to report to the allotted institute at the specified time. It is compulsory for all the participants to carry all the required documents (original plus photocopy) to the institution.

Once candidates have submitted the admission fee in the respective institution they are advised to collect the candidate's copy or admission confirmation slip from the concerned department of the institution.

Documents/Certificates Required

Candidates have to carry all the given documents and certificates in original along with the attested copy of each at the time of admission at the allotted institutions-

- Seat allotment letter
- Birth certificate
- SSC (Class X) mark sheet and certificate
- HSC certificate
- Domicile certificate
- Caste or category certificate
- School leaving certificate
- Two passport size photograph (must be recent)
- Address proof
